Get to know some of the NPRC interventions to address conflict related Gender Based Violence

The Commission seeks to address past gender-based violations in all their dimensions by putting in place measures for redress for those who have suffered the violations and develop systems and structures to prevent similar violations in the future.

As mandated by the Constitution Section 252 (f), the Commission continues to receive and consider complaints on human rights violations arising from a shared or common dispute or conflict, including cases of conflict related Gender Based Violence.

Conflict is gendered, violence affects women and girls disproportionately and women have during past episodes of violent conflicts in the country experienced deeper forms of violence than men in the form of Sexual Gender Based Violence. Acknowledging the gendered impacts of conflicts and violence on men and women is therefore critical. Attesting to this, most victims who seek recourse from the Commission are women.
