#### **Know some of the NPRC interventions to address conflict related Gender Based Violence:**

The NPRC has considered it key to ensure structural, systemic and operational prevention of violence and conflicts hence the Commission is setting up and institutionalizing a National Conflict Early Warning and Early Response (CEWER) system.

The framework provides indicators of conflict which will be instrumental to detect hotspots of potential conflicts and mobilize for coordinated and timely national response before the occurrence of the conflicts.

In consideration that GBV is an indicator of rising tensions and incipient conflict and stands as a major obstacle for the achievement of sustainable peace and development, the CEWER system has clear GBV Indicators which are meant to contribute to the monitoring of progress in addressing conflict related GBV.

Some of the GBV related indicators in the CEWER system are-;

- Increased cases of abuse, harassment of women in political and electoral processes
- Increased reports of sexual and gender-based violence
- Increased gender-based violence due to natural resource- based conflict
- Increase in Domestic violence, interpersonal violence, Gender-Based Violence and rates of suicide
